INSTRUCTIONS: Dr. Mulley performs her Dental Procedures on Thursdays at the Central Victoria Veterinary Hospital.

FOOD and WATER must be taken away by 10pm on Wednesday evening. If your pet is on oral medication, do not give on the morning of the Dentistry. Medication can be given again later that evening as directed.

ADMITTANCE TIME: between 7:00 - 7:45am Thursday morning. Arrangements can be made to admit Wednesday evening if required.

- When you arrive at the Central Victoria Veterinary Hospital, the reception staff will have your pet surgery file ready and will ask you questions regarding allergies, medications, and other pertinent information. They will also have a consent form for you to sign. Once the paperwork is completed, a ward nurse will take your pet back to the kennels. If you wish to accompany them, you may do so.
- Dr. Mulley will call to update you after all procedures have been completed. Patients are generally discharged in the late afternoon.
- When you pick up your pet, the reception staff will review typed post-dental care instructions with you.
- Some patients may require a pre-anesthetic blood screen before any Dentistry is performed. This lab work is recommended for patients that are seven years of age or older.
