INSTRUCTIONS: Dr. Mulley performs her Surgical Procedures on Tuesday Afternoons at the Central Victoria Veterinary Hospital.

FOOD must be taken away by Midnight Monday evening. **WATER** is okay until 8am Tuesday morning. If your pet is on oral medication, do not give on the morning of the surgery. Medication can be given again later that evening as directed.

ADMITTANCE TIME: between 7:00 to 10:30am Tuesday morning. Arrangements can be made to admit Monday evening if required.

- When you arrive at the Central Victoria Veterinary Hospital, the reception staff will have your pets surgery file ready and will ask you questions regarding allergies, medications, and other pertinent information. They will also have a consent form for you to sign. Once the paperwork is completed, a ward nurse will take your pet back to the kennels. If you wish to accompany them, you may do so.
- Dr. Mulley will call to update you after all procedures have been completed. Patients are generally discharged in the evening between 6 and 8:30pm.
- When you pick up your pet, the reception staff will review typed post-operative care instructions with you.
- Some patients may require a pre-anesthetic blood screen before any surgery is performed. This lab work is recommended for patients that are seven years of age or older.



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
