Pre Dental Procedure Instructions

INSTRUCTIONS:

FOOD must be taken away by midnight the night before your pets surgery. Water is okay until 7:00am the morning of the surgery. If your pet is on ORAL MEDICATION, do not give it on the morning of the surgery.

ADMITTANCE TIME is between 7:00 and 7:30am. Arrangements can be made to admit earlier or the evening prior if required.

When your pet returns home in the evening they can have a small meal (1/3 of their usual amount), and then resume normal meals the following day. Medications can be given in the evening as directed.

- When you arrive at the Central Victoria Veterinary Hospital, the reception staff will have your pets file ready and will ask you questions regarding allergies, medications, and other pertinent information. They will also have a consent form for you to sign. Once the paperwork is completed, a ward nurse will take your pet back to the kennels. If you wish to accompany them, you may do so.
- Please leave a phone number where Dr. Mulley can reach you if she has any questions prior to or during the procedure.
- Dr. Mulley will call to update you after all procedures have been completed (approximately 12:00 noon). Patients are generally discharged in the evening between 4:00 and 8:30pm.
- When you pick up your pet, the reception staff will review post-operative care instructions with you.
- Some patients may require a pre-anesthetic blood screen before any surgery is performed. This lab work is required for patients that are seven years of age or older, however it may also be recommended for any pet depending on their condition.
